



L'EQUIPE EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP

Anzio, Italy 1-7 August 2010

NOTICE OF RACE

The 2010 L'EQUIPE European Championship will be held in Anzio - Italy from 1st to 7th August. The event is organized by Lega Navale Italiana Anzio, in cooperation with Italian L'Equipe Class Association and L'Equipe International Association (EIA).

1. RULES

The Event will be governed by:

- The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing for 2009 - 2012
- The L'EQUIPE Class Rules (except as altered by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions)
- The Notice of Race
- The Sailing Instructions

Direct judging on the water will be used for infringements of RRS Part 2 as provided in the Sailing Instructions.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at the Regatta Office from 11.00am on August 1st, 2010.

3. ELEGIBILITY

Only competitors born after 31 December 1994 are entitled to compete.

Competitors shall comply with the eligibility requirements of RRS Appendix 2.

Each boat must be covered by a third part liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500.000 € for the duration of the regatta.

4. ADVERTISING

The event is classified as a category C event (RRS Appendix 1).

Competitors may be required to display on their hulls advertising under RRS rules Appendix 1.20.3.1 (d) (i). All Class Rules in contradiction with the rule are altered.

5. ENTRIES

Entries are to be made with the enclosed entry form and shall be delivered **before July 10th, 2010** to:

Each competitor shall personally register and sign the registration form at the Race Office before 12.00am on August 2nd, 2010. Registration is subject to the presentation, before that time, of the following documents:

- A health certificate proving the ability at nautical sports (validity 3 months maximum when presented separately from the licence)
- Parent's agreement for child under 18 years old
- The original Measurement Certificate of the boat
- The authorization of the relevant National Authority to display individual advertising as permitted in RRD Appendix 1 for category C events
- The relevant National Authority License
- For competitors not living in Poland, a certificate proving he is a member of a national authority of his country or of a Club affiliated to it, and a certificate of third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.500.000 €. The document shown shall be the original issued by the insurance company.

6. PREVISIONAL PROGRAM

The provisional program is as follow:

7. SCORING

The low point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A) will apply.

A scratch score will be established (all competitors taken together).

Two overall results will be then done:

- men / mixed
- women

8. SAIL AND EQUIPMENT STAMPING - MEASUREMENT

The competitors shall present for stamping the following equipment: hull; centreboard; rudder; rigging; 1 or 2 set of "L'EQUIPE evolution" sails.

Attention is called concerning sail numbers and national letters Class Rules (size, colour, position).

No boat can take part in the regatta while using sails not previously stamped.

Measurement checks may be made daily.



9. SUPPORT BOATS

All support boats are required to register at the Regatta Office prior to 12:00am on August 2nd, 2010 and must display their national flag on the water.

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to:

- the youngest crew
- the top three crews
- the top three crews in the women results
- the winner crew will take the European Trophy which will be held, by the winning country, for one year and then given back to the EIA for the next Championship.

11. DISCLAIMER

All those taking part in the event do so at their own risk and responsibility.

The Organizing Committee are any part involved with the organization of the event disclaim any and every responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage, injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and goods, both ashore and at sea as a consequence of participation in the races covered by this Notice of Race.

Attention is drawn to the RRS Fundamental Rule 4 –Decision to Race, which states: “the responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone”

12. RIGHT TO USE NAMES AND LIKENESS

In participating in the regatta a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of the regatta the right in perpetuity to make use and show from time to time and at their discretion any motion pictures and live taped and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition and in all material related to the regatta without compensation.
